

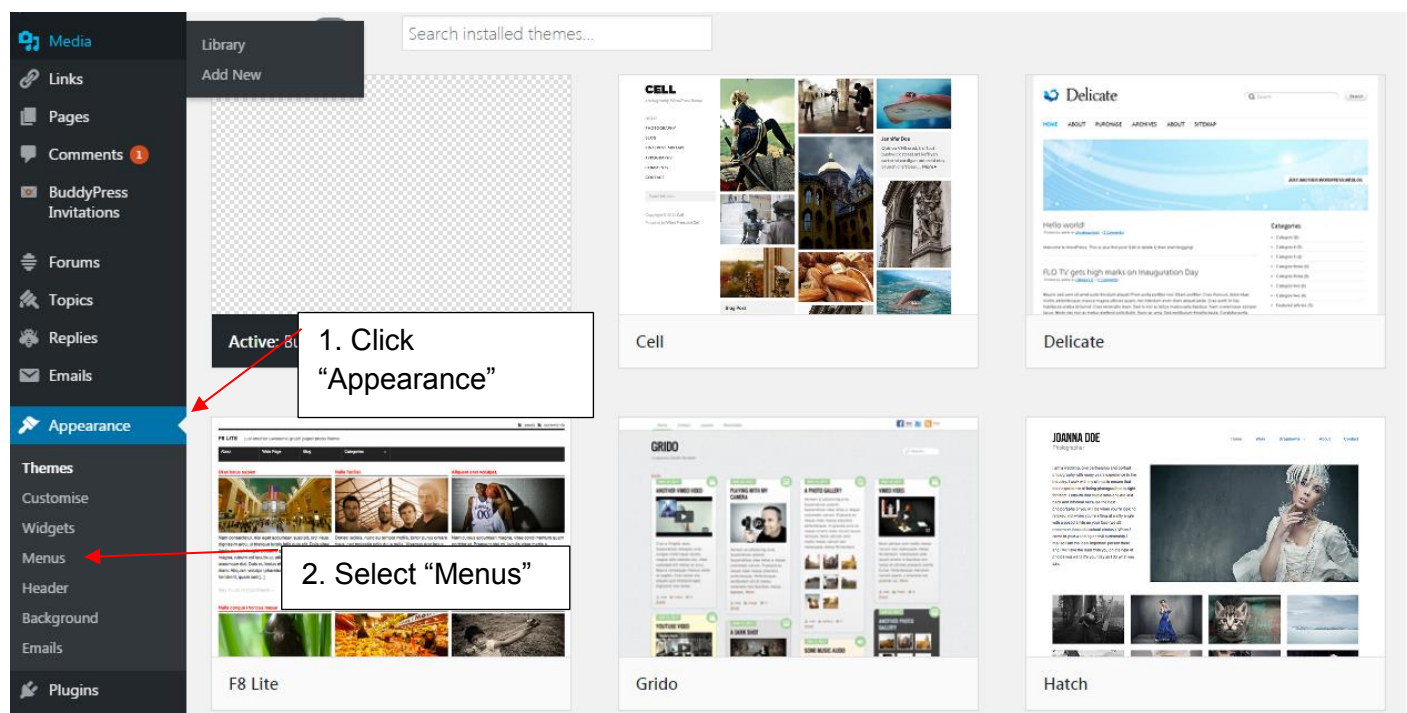
Adding a Menu

How do I create a Menu?

This feature allows you to use a custom menu in place of your theme's default menus. If your theme does not support the custom menus feature yet, you can learn about adding this support by following the Documentation link: <https://goo.gl/2TsXmv>

You can still use the "Custom Menu" widget to add menus to a sidebar.

You can create custom menus for your site. These menus may contain links to pages, categories, custom links or other content types. You can specify a different navigation label for a menu item as well as other attributes. You can create multiple menus. If your theme includes more than one menu, you can choose which custom menu to associate with each. You can also use custom menus in conjunction with the Custom Menu widget.



1. Edit Menu

2. Create a new menu

3. Click "Create a new menu"

4. Give a name to a Menu and click "Create Menu"

5. Select menu items

6. Click "Add to Menu"

7. Click "Save Menu"
